



# THE THREE WOMEN

*Mark 16:1-8*

Three women who were friends of Jesus watched where Jesus had been buried. Jesus died on Friday. The next day was the Sabbath (*the day when people went to church*). It was the saddest Passover Sabbath in their whole life. Their Master was dead and buried! They cried and talked quietly with one another. They decided to get up early Sunday and bring their oils and spices to show that they loved their Lord and Master. As they walked, they were saying to each other, *"Who shall roll away the stone from the door of the tomb?"* As they came near they saw that the stone was rolled away and an angel was there. The angel said: *"I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here. He is risen, even as He said. Come see the place where the Lord lay. Then go quickly and tell His disciples."*
