

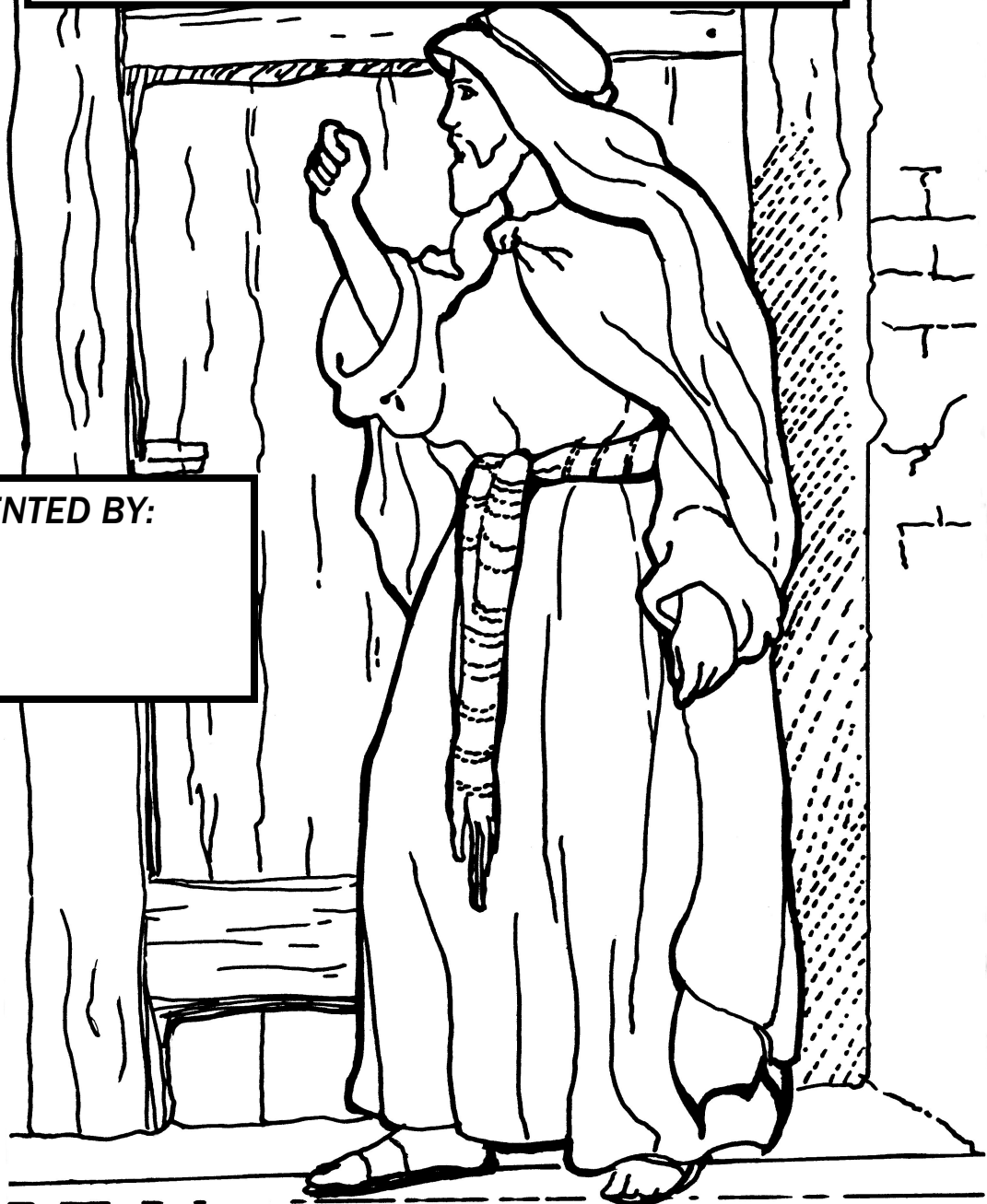

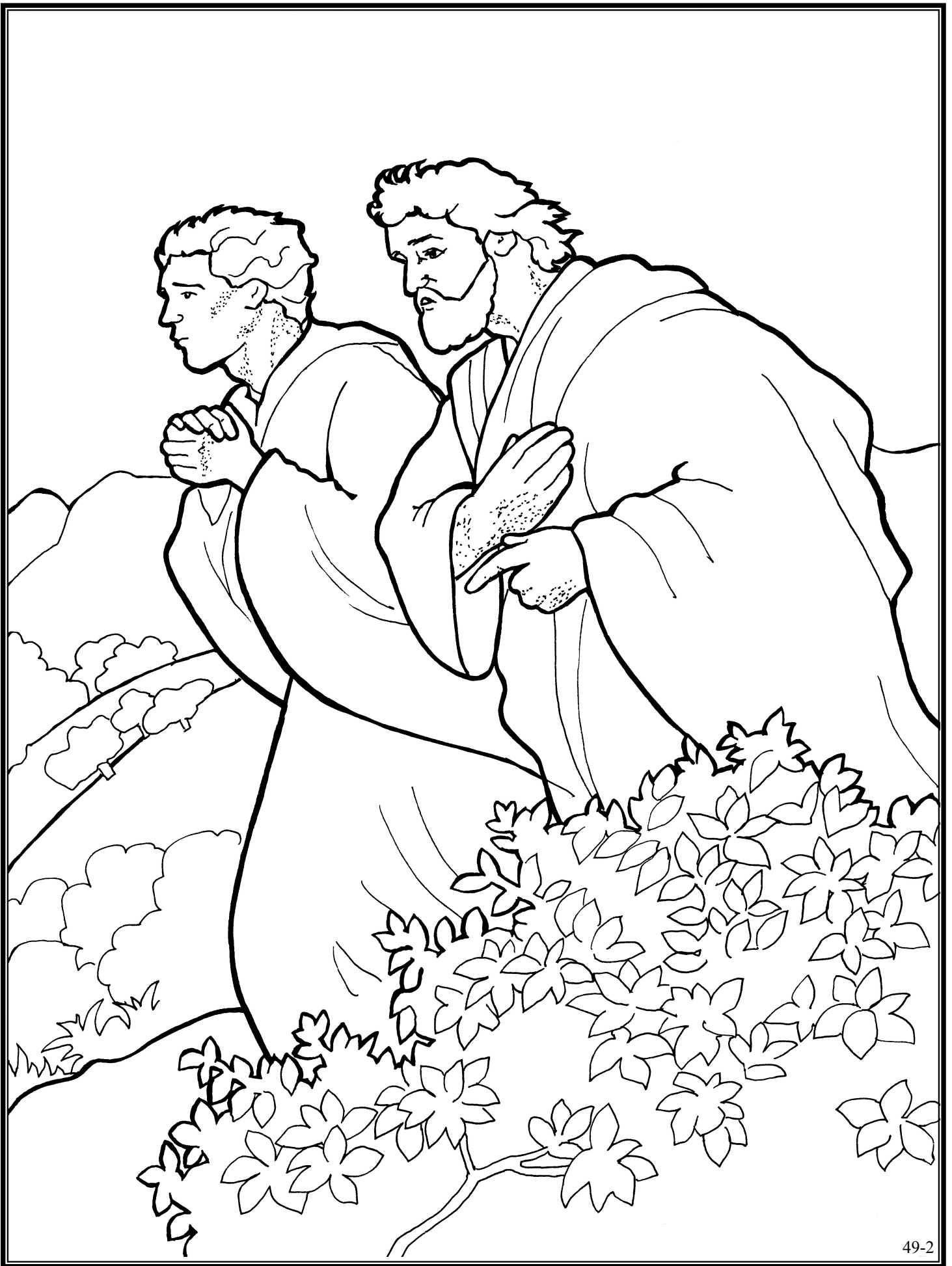

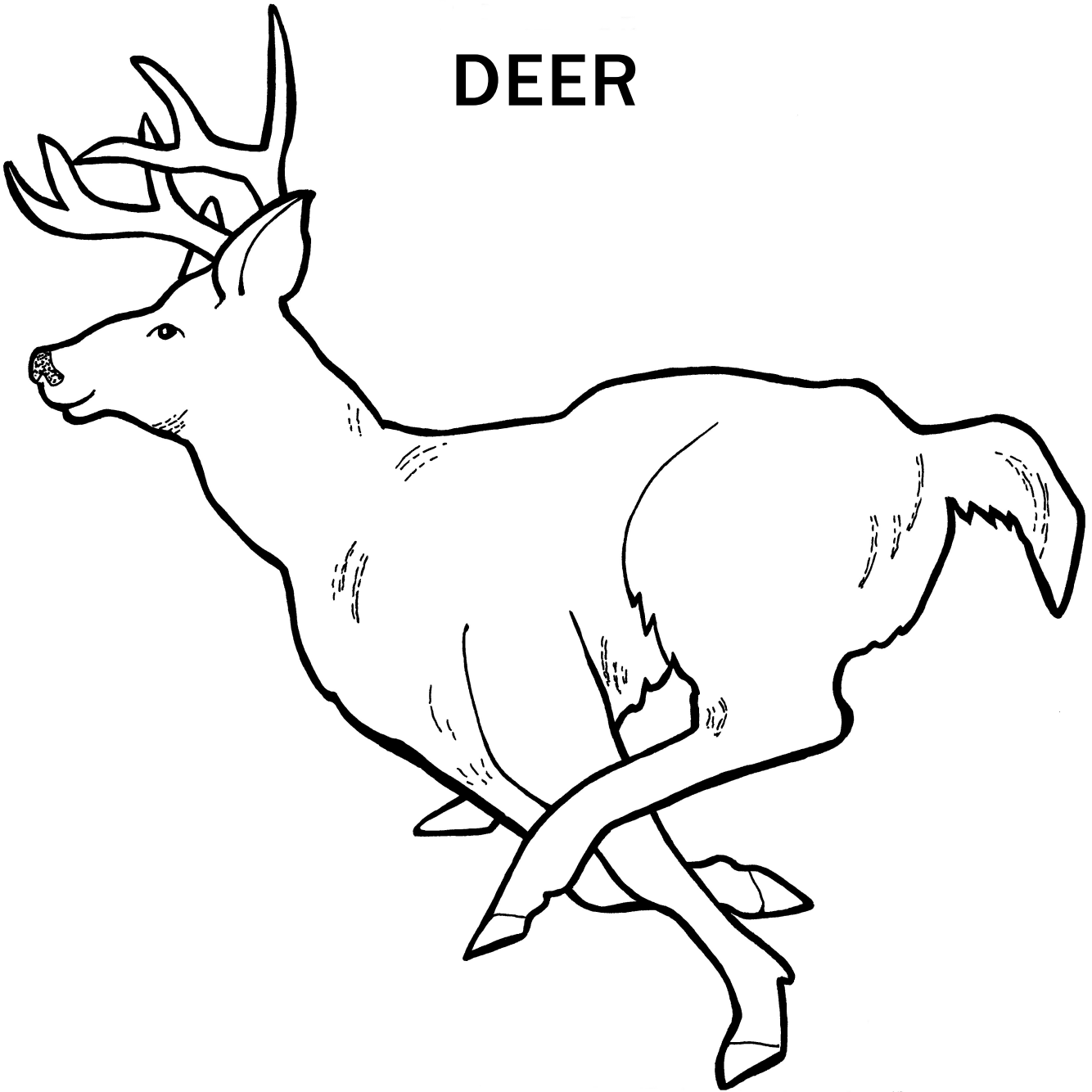
We thank You for Your Resurrection. We know that we too will be raised from the dead and live with you in heaven forever. Amen
