Hide your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquity. Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit to sustain me." When God forgives us, our dark sins are washed as white as snow.

Snow is used by God as a word picture of how His Holy Word (the Bible) does the good work God wants it to. We learn this in Isaiah 55:10-11, "As the rain and the snow come down from heaven and do not return to it without watering the earth and making it bud and flourish (grow) so that it yields seed for the sower and bread for the eater, so is my word that goes out from my mouth. It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the

purpose for which I sent it." Just as God sends snow and rain to give life to all on earth, He also sends His Holy Word to give life to our souls and lead us to faith in Jesus and eternal life in heaven.
