The Bread of Life



When you eat this bread, you will be hungry again. Jesus, the bread of life, satisfies our hunger for righteousness and peace with God the Father and we will not be hungry for righteousness anymore.

John 6:35 | “I (Jesus) am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry and he who believes in me will never be thirsty.”

John 6:33 | The bread of God is he who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world.”

Bread is an important item found in most homes. It provides much of what the body needs to survive. Every country makes bread that is special to its people. Everyone is familiar with bread and that is why Jesus uses bread to explain about Himself.

Jesus says in Matthew 5:6, "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness for they will be filled." This is not the same as being hungry or thirsty for food and drink. If we hunger and thirst for righteousness, Jesus is the living bread that feeds our soul. Bread that you eat does not last and you become hungry again. Bread that is left uneaten too long will get moldy. The living bread which is Jesus is different. Faith in Jesus does not leave

our soul hungry or thirsty. Jesus, the living bread, does not spoil with time. Jesus is the same yesterday, today and tomorrow.

Believe in Jesus as your Savior and your soul will be well fed with the living bread that satisfies completely. Nothing else is needed.
