

THE STORY OF TWO HOUSES

MATTHEW 7:24-29

Many times Jesus told a story to teach some important truth. The story of the two houses shows how important it is for boys and girls, men and women, to build their lives on God's Word.

The two houses looked alike. Both houses had beautiful rooms. But there was a big difference - one was built on a rock and one was built on sand. Everything went well until one day a bad storm came. The one built on the rock stood up against the storm. The one built on the sand was washed away. Jesus is sometimes called THE ROCK. Let us build on Him alone for our salvation.

I pray Thee, dear Lord Jesus, my heart to keep and train. Teach me always to build my faith on you. Amen


Bible passage for older children to memorize:
