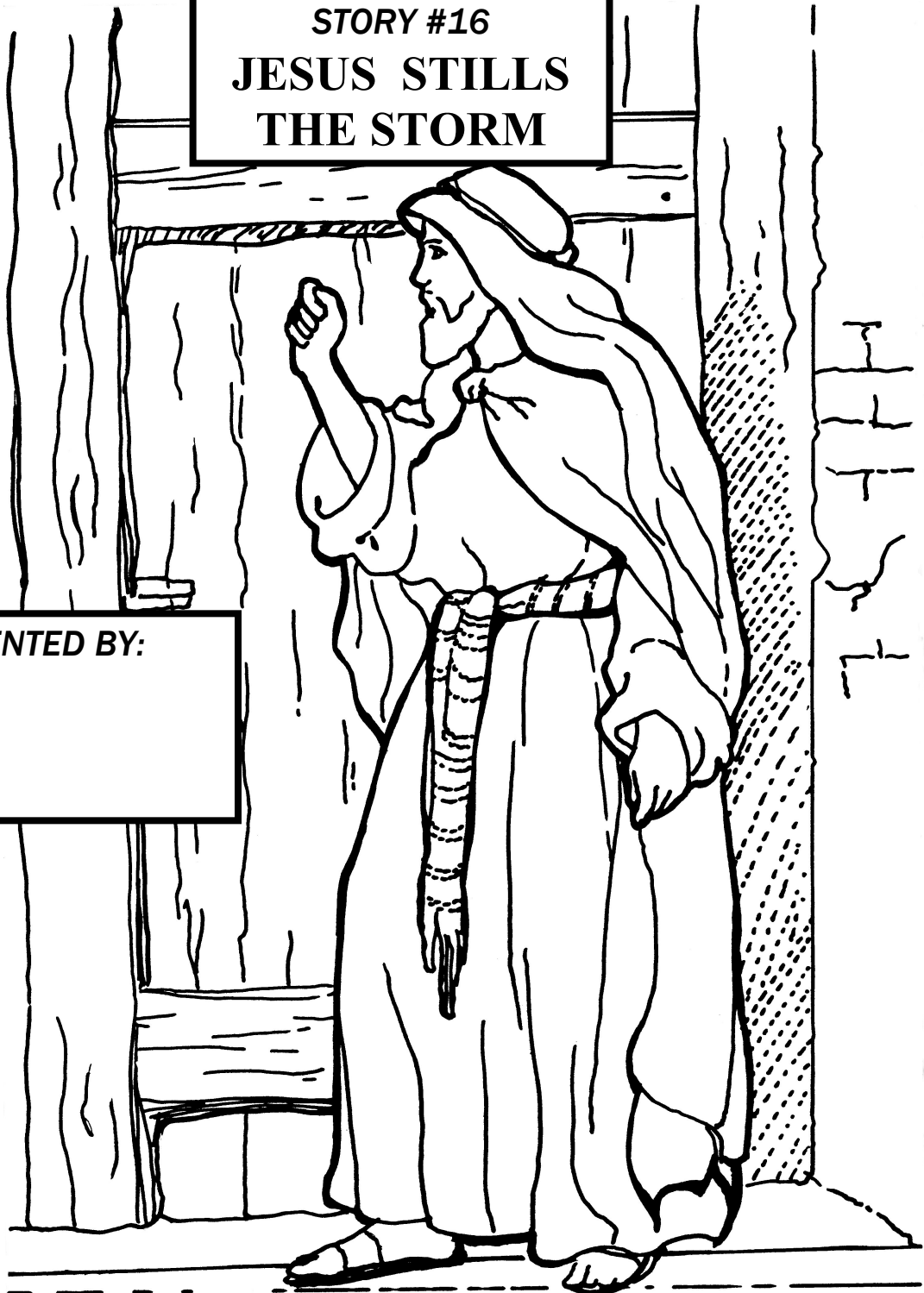


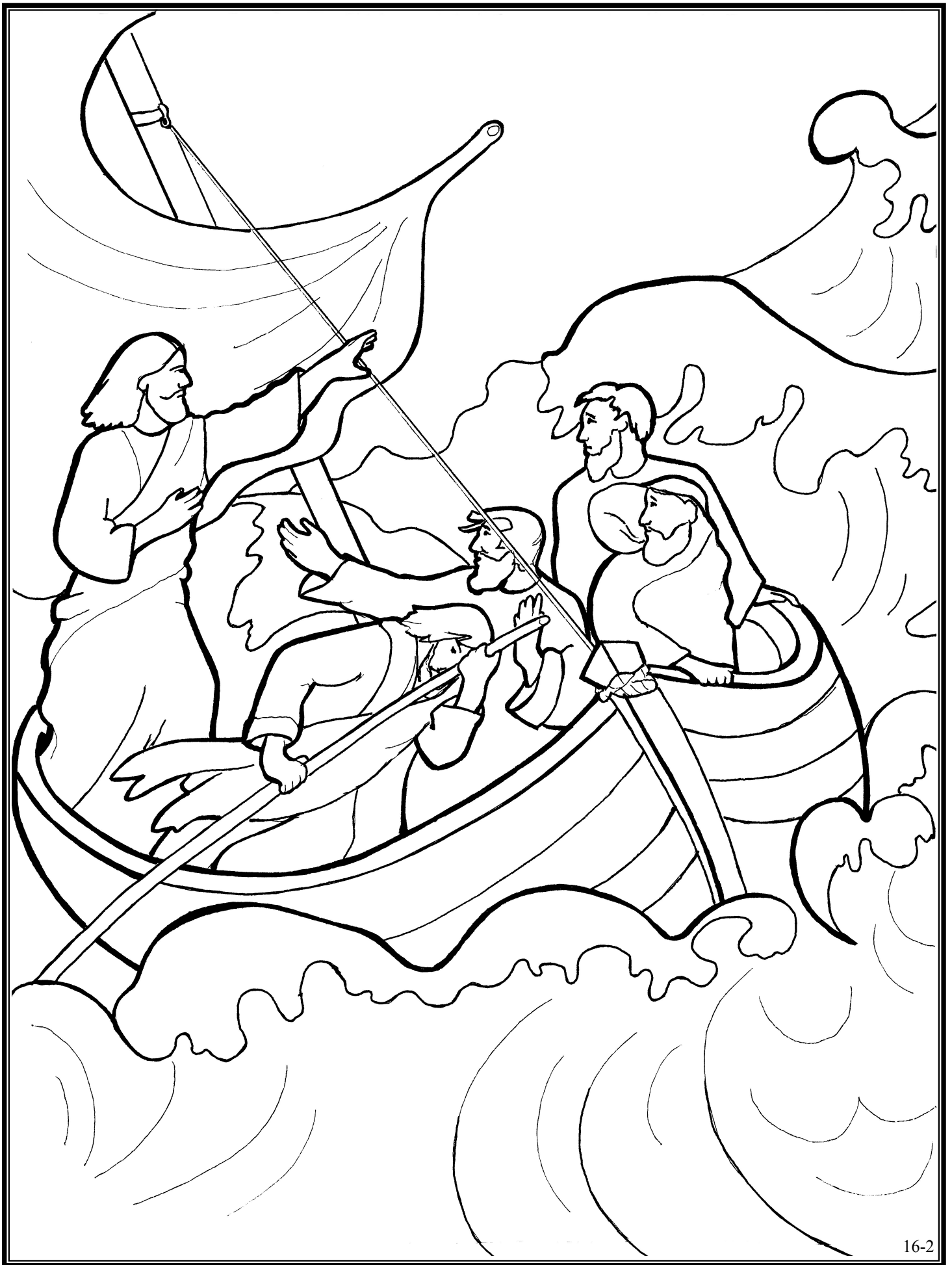

JESUS STILL THE STORM

MATTHEW 8:23-27

The disciples of Jesus knew how to handle a boat because most of them had been fishermen. But one time a storm came upon them that they could not handle. PRAYER

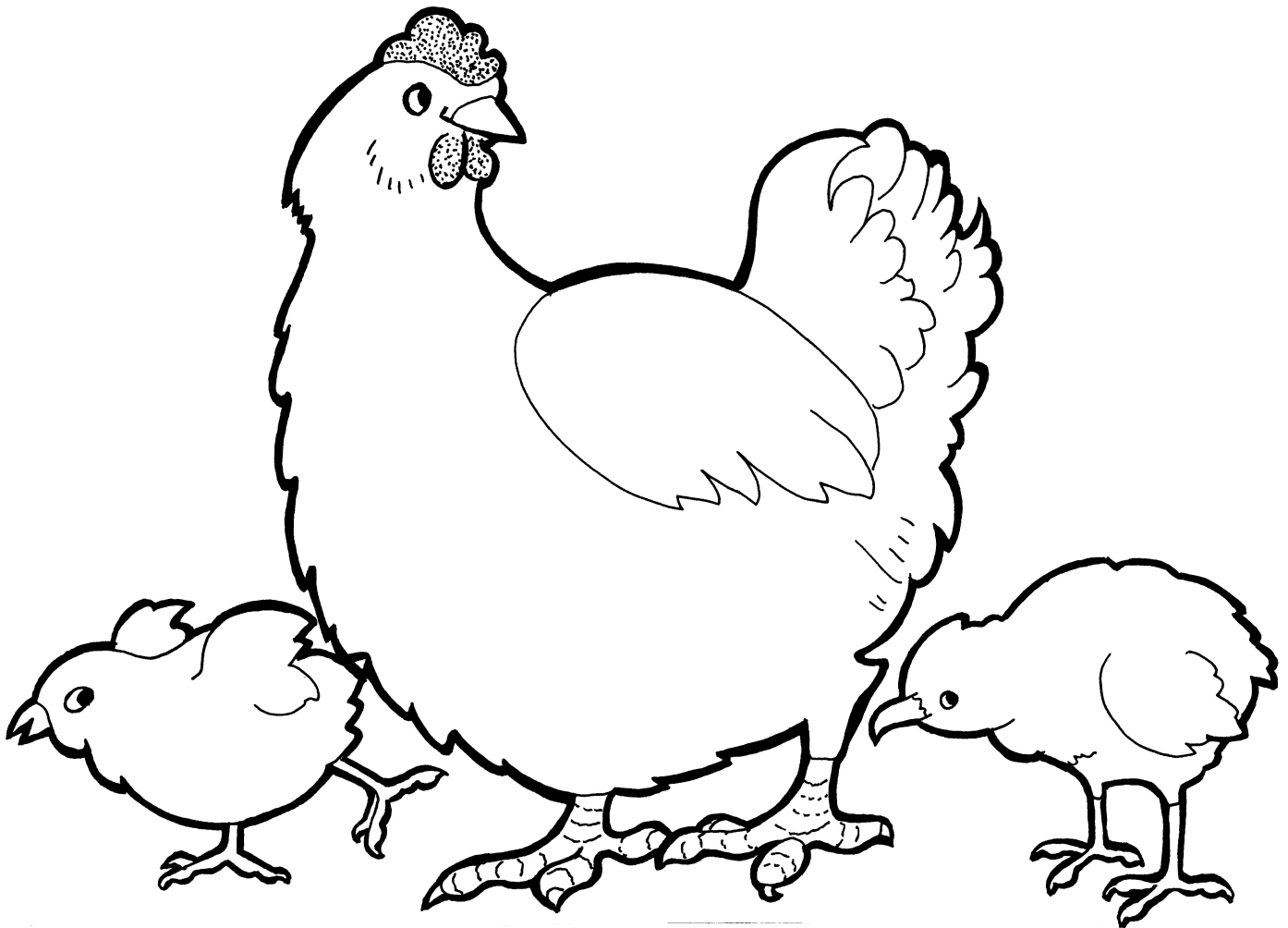
Jesus, I know you will take care of us. Let your holy angel be with us and protect us in every danger. In Jesus Name, Amen.
