MATTHEW 9:27-31


Jesus met two men who could not see anything. If you close your eyes you can tell what it is like to be blind. Everything is dark. These blind men heard that Jesus was coming. They followed Him and cried out very loud: "Have mercy (pity) on us, Son of David!" Jesus said to them: "Do you believe that I am able to do this?" They said to him: "Yes, Lord." Then Jesus touched their eyes, saying: "According to your faith will it be done to you." Then the blind men's eyes were opened and they could see.
