


THE GOOD SAMARITAN

LUKE 10:30-37

Jesus told this story to people who had asked: "Who is my neighbor?"

A man went alone on this road and was beaten up by bad men who robbed him and left him badly hurt. Some people from the church in Jerusalem found him on the side of the road. Lord, help me to be a friend, even as Jesus is our friend.


