


THE PRAYERS OF TWO MEN

LUKE 18:9-14

To pray is to have a heart-to-heart talk with God. When we are sick we ask God to make us well. We ask God to forgive our sins because Jesus died for us. We pray for ourselves and for others. We thank God because He is so good to us.

One day two men went to church to pray. One man stood up front and thanked God that he was better than other people. He bragged about the good he thought he had done. Another man came to pray. He stood in the back corner of the church, and looking down, said: "God, have mercy on me, a sinner." He was ashamed of himself, he didn't brag, but told God that he had done wrong. He asked God to forgive his sins. Jesus, who knows what people think, said that the one who admitted his sin and asked for forgiveness went home saved. God was pleased with that man's prayer and not with the other man who bragged about himself.

PRAYER


Dear Lord Jesus, we tell you that we have done wrong and look to you for forgiveness. Amen

PSALM 32:5


I said, "I confess my transgression (sins) to the Lord" - and you forgave the guilt of my sins.
