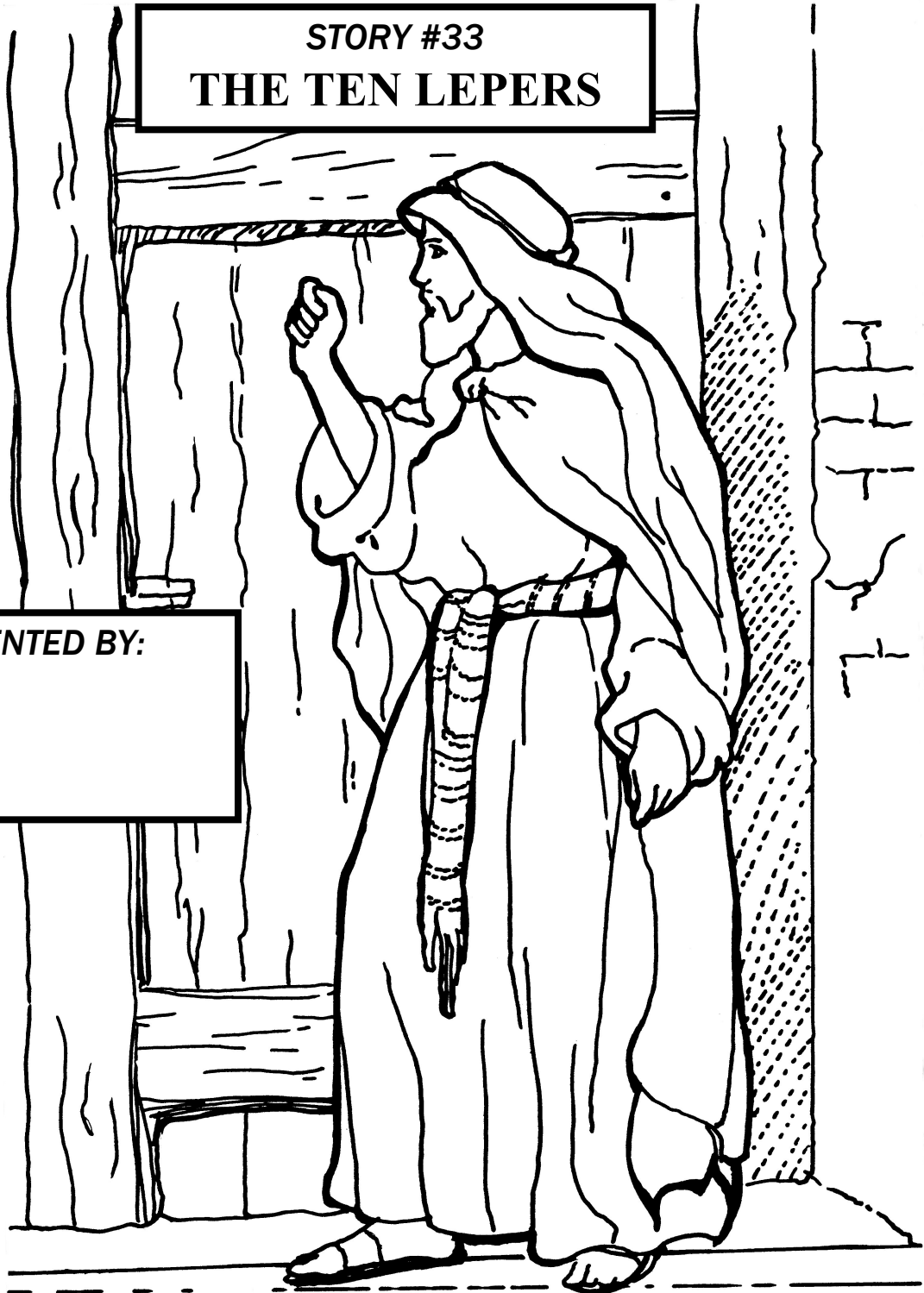


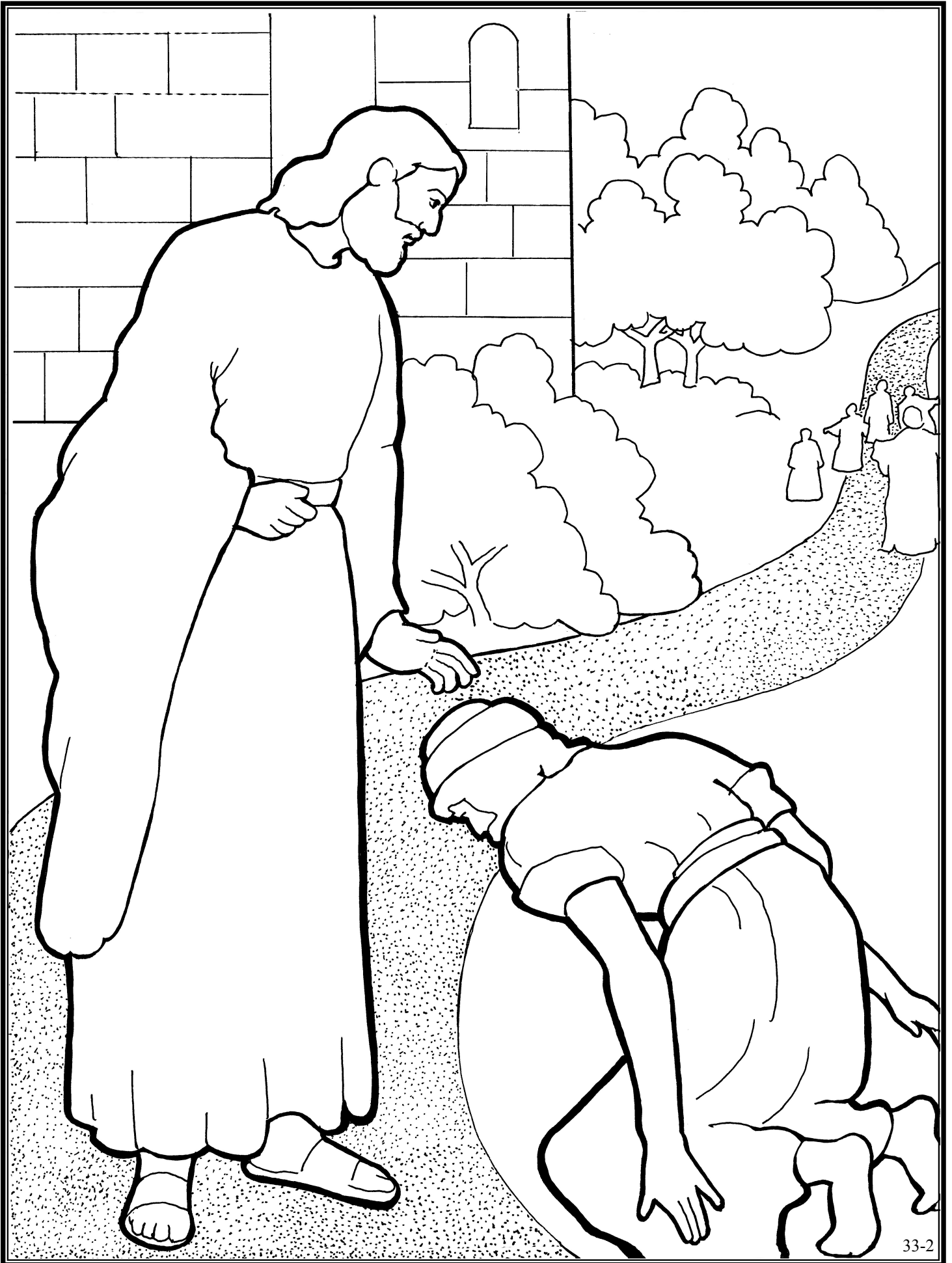

# THE TEN LEPERS

**LUKE 17:11-19**

Nobody wanted to go near lepers because they were very sick. People who touched them might have gotten sick too. Lepers lived by themselves away from people in town. Ten lepers had heard about Jesus and His power to heal. When they saw Jesus they called to Him and said: *"Jesus, Master, have pity on us!"* Jesus heard them calling to him. He wanted to help them and so He made them all well. He healed all of them but only one of them came back to tell Him, *"Thank You."* This one man was so glad that he was made well that he fell down in front of Jesus. ## **PRAYER**

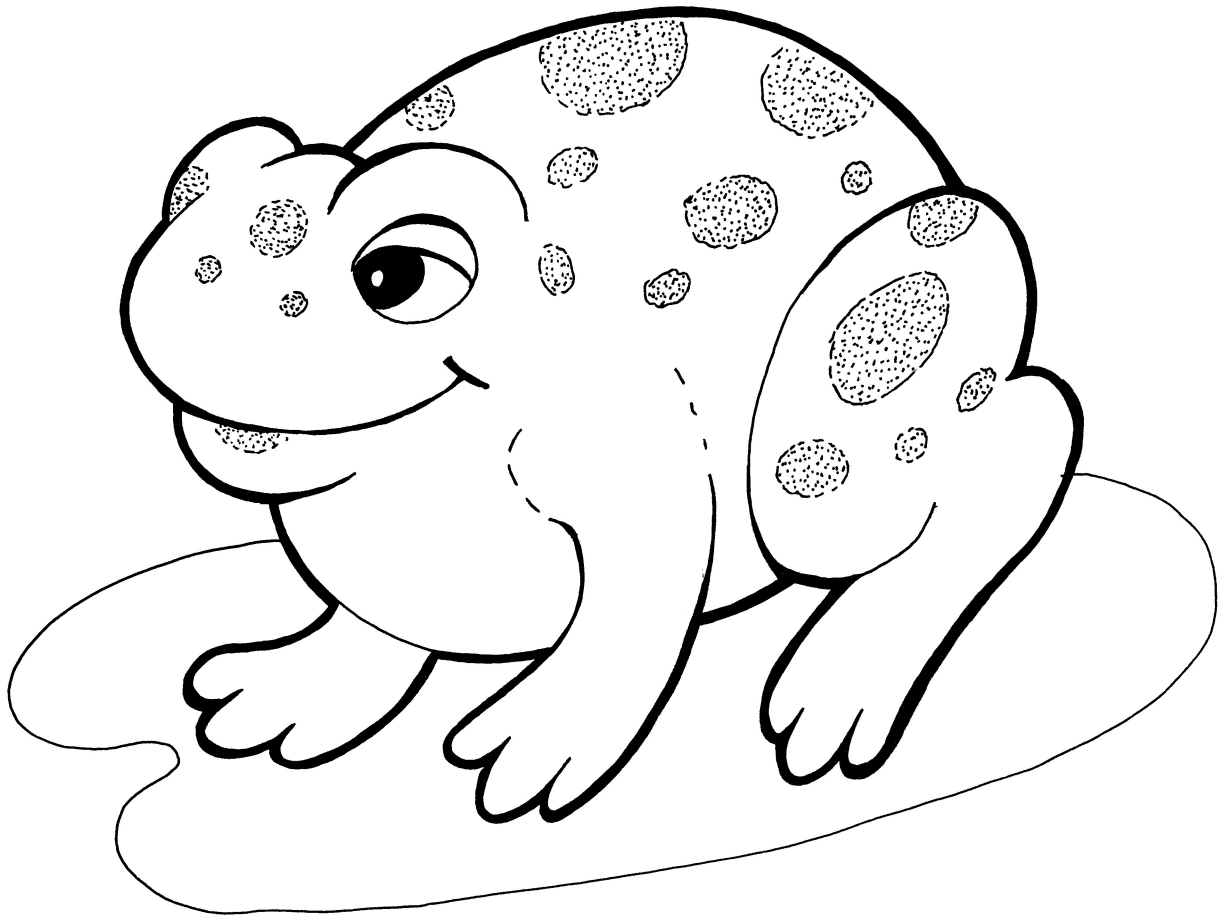

# FROG
