


## THE LAST SUPPER

**MATTHEW 26:26-28**

Jesus told them to eat the bread. And as they ate He said: "Take and eat; this is my body." Then he took the cup, gave thanks and offered it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you. We have done bad things that God must punish. But Jesus was punished instead of us.


#### **PRAYER**
