


Dear Jesus, You are the Friend of sinners. You died for us and kept all of God's commandments for us. May we always trust in Jesus as our Savior. Amen

ANIMALS FROM THE BIBLE

SERPENT



The serpent is mentioned many times in the Bible. It is usually described as evil or dangerous. The serpent is often used to represent Satan.

There are many kinds of serpents in nature. Some are dangerous but most are not. Serpents help to keep down the large numbers of harmful pests in our world and are in this way helpful to people.

The devil tempted Jesus three times in the wilderness. To win the spiritual battle, Jesus used the power of the Word of God to overcome Satan. (When we battle Satan, the words of God in the Bible will defend us too.) Here are the three examples of Bible passages He used to fight and win against Satan...

MATTHEW 4:4

Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.' "

MATTHEW 4:7

Jesus answered him, "It is also written: 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test.' "

MATTHEW 4:10

Jesus said to him, "Away from me, Satan! For it is written: 'Worship the Lord your God, and serve Him only.' "
