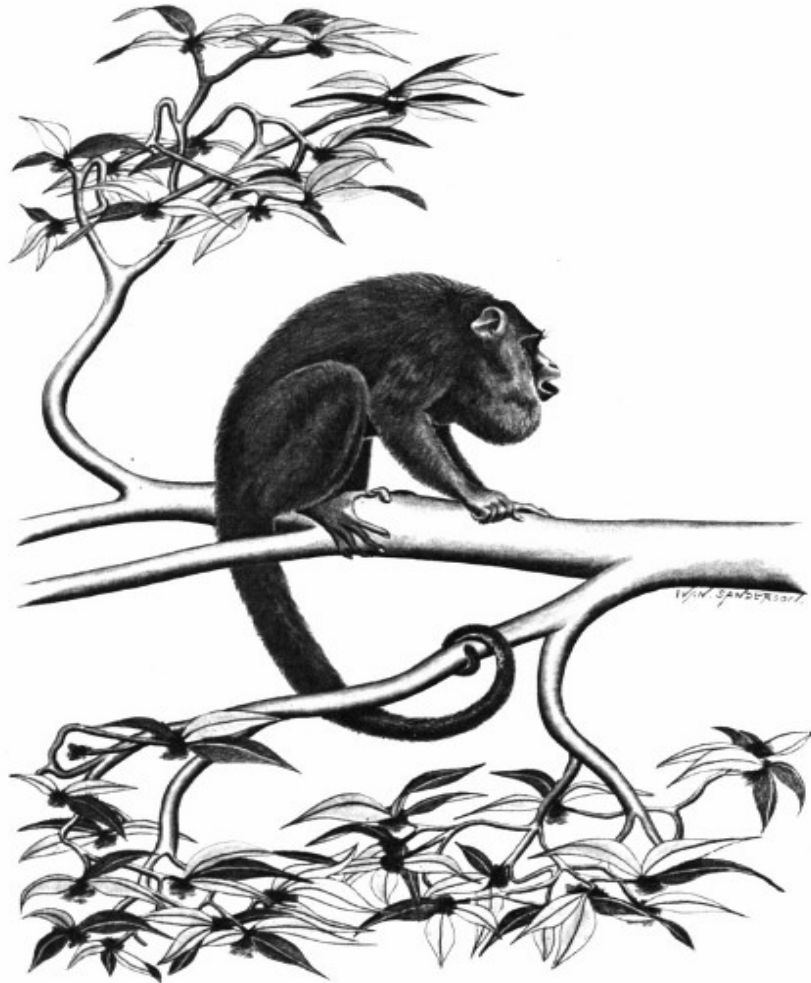


Lesson 9

God's Animal Kingdom Classroom

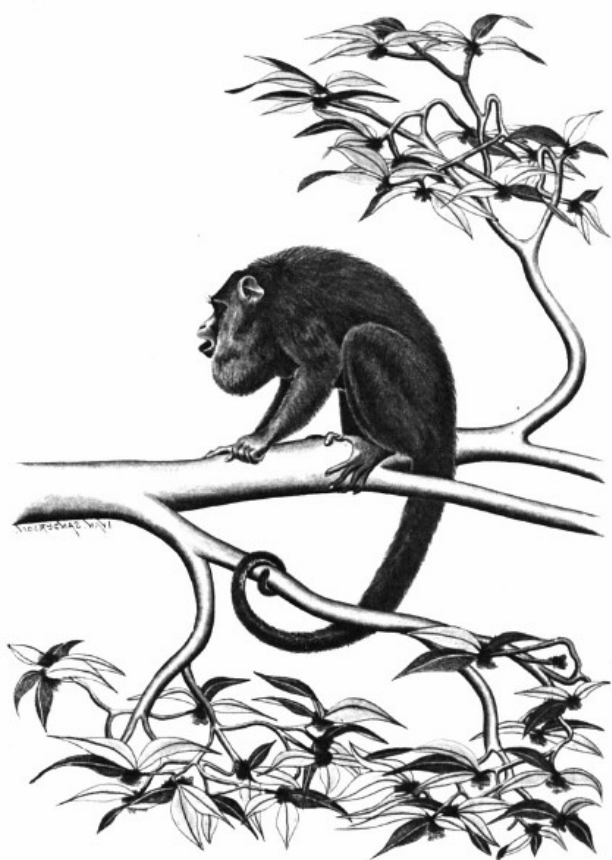
Howler Monkey
