## **SPRING**

The Bible also tells us in Psalm 30:2-4, "O Lord my God, I called to you for help and you healed me. O Lord, you brought me up from the grave; you spared me from going down into the pit (hell). Sing to the Lord, you saints of his; praise his holy name."
