Squirrel

The Bible tells us in Philippians 3:13, "I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus." The Bible also tells us in 2nd Samuel 12:20, "Turn not aside from

following the Lord but serve the Lord with all your heart." We should not let anything stop us from sharing our faith, hope and joy in Jesus with others.
